A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Northeast Iowa Community College Associate of Applied Science (AAS) does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

Upper Iowa University also offers **Graduate Link Programs**. These Graduate Link Programs allow students to take graduate level courses as part of their undergraduate degree.
